

Cabot School Board DRAFT vision statement

Thinking about Rory's goals for future feasibility from 8/23/21 meeting: mainly about expanding opportunities for Cabot students through collaboration with other schools in the SU.

The Board envisions:

- Cabot School becoming more collaborative with the other schools in the SU for the enrichment and benefit of the students and staff, leading to additional opportunities for all in the Cabot School community. This would include the sharing of resources such as academic, athletic, personnel, curriculum, and instructional opportunities.
- Cabot graduates being successful in their chosen pursuits because of the experiential learning that they received at Cabot School. (need to be able to have data on graduates-college success rates, retention rates in their field...).
- Cabot School and the Board initiating ongoing engagement with the broader townwide community for their mutual benefit, making the school relevant to the entire town, even those without children in the school.
